### **Curriculum Features**

Symphonic and Marching Band, broad range of Art classes, Drama, Chorus, Musical Theater, Journalism, Spanish, German, American Sign Language, and JROTC. The Legion of Generals Marching Band performed at the Fiesta Bowl in 2010, won 10 Grand Championships between 2012 and 2016, and received GMEA's Exemplary Performance Award in 2012 and 2015.

### **Theater**

The Heritage High School theater has seating for 915 and full theatrical lighting. Past productions include the musicals *Sister Act*, *Shrek*, *Legally Blonde*, *The Wizard of Oz*, *Cinderella*, *Hairspray*, *The Little Mermaid*, *Alice in Wonderland*, *Grease*, and the dramas *See How They Run*, *Night Chill (Edgar Allan Poe)*, *Psycho*, *The Importance of Being Earnest*, *Arsenic and Old Lace*, *And Then There Were None*, and *Harvey*.
